Academic session 2025 – 26 through TQT – 2025**

(All Dates are tentative subject to permission from Govt. Authorities)

1. Registration :

From : 06th – Jan – 2025 to 18th – Jan – 2025 at SSS-10

Timings : *For candidates from Non-BSP Schools.*

10.00 pm to 02.00 pm, Mon to Sat. (on working days only)

Candidates form BSP Schools will get their Registration Forms from their respective school.

Regn. Fee – Rs 150/- (BSP/At Par); Rs 350/- (Non-BSP)

Note : BSP / At Par wards will have to show relevant proof
(Last Pay Slip or valid Medical OPD book Cover Page of wards)

2. Submission of filled-in registration forms:

From : 9th Jan 2025 to 23th Jan 2025 at SSS-10.

Timing : 10:00 am to 2:00 pm, on all working days

Photocopy of the following documents to be submitted along with registration form :

- i. Class-VIII Report Card upto Term-I / Half-Yearly duly attested by School Head / Principal (if available)
- ii. Last Pay Slip or valid Medical OPD book Cover Page – for the wards of BSP / At Par Employees
- iii. Certificate in support for application under special category:
 - a. National Level achievement in Sports & / or Cultural fields
 - b. Physically Challenged with competent authority

* *Candidates applying under above reserved categories must fill appropriate columns in application form.*

Candidates form BSP Schools will submit their Registration Forms at their respective schools.

3. Conduct of TQT- 2025 (at BSP Senior Secondary School Sector-10, Bhilai):

Sunday, 02-Feb-2025 / 10:00 am to 1:00 pm; candidates shall report at their centre by 9.30 am, positively.

Model Answers shall be announced on 02nd Feb 2025 immediately after the exam at Exam Centre Notice Board(s).

If they do not fulfill any of the eligibility criteria for admission, the Provisional Admission shall be cancelled. The Provisional Admission of candidates fulfilling all the eligibility criteria and joining requirements shall be confirmed thereafter.

EXAMINATION SPECIFICATION
TenQuestTest (TQT – 2025)

1. Syllabus :

- a. Mathematics, Social Science and General Science – NCERT syllabus up to Class VIII.
- b. English Grammar and comprehension upto Class VIII.
- c. MAT(Mental Ability Test) – To judge the candidate's power of reasoning, ability to think, ability to judge, evaluate or discriminate, ability to visualize in space, and power of reasoning.

2. Question Paper :

- a. Number of Questions : Total 125 questions of equal marks.
 - b. Subject wise Distribution
 - i. **20 Question on English**
 - ii. **20 Question on MAT**
 - iii. **30 Question on Mathematics**
 - iv. **35 Questions on Science**
 - v. **20 Questions on Social Science**
 - c. **Question Type** : Only multiple choice questions with four options
 - d. **Duration of Exam** : 3 Hrs.
(including $\frac{1}{2}$ hr for filling entries in OMR sheet)
 - e. Answer should be marked on OMR sheet using **Black Ballpoint Pen only.**
3. For each correct answer 4 (four) marks will be given and for each incorrect answer 1 (One) mark will be deducted.
- 4. Resolution of Tie :**
- In case of tie (same total score) at any position in merit prepared for admission, tie would be resolved by giving sequential weightage to subjects as follows :
- Higher score in Maths.
 - Followed by higher score in Science.
 - Followed by higher score in Social Science.
 - Followed by higher score in MAT.
 - Followed by higher score in English.
